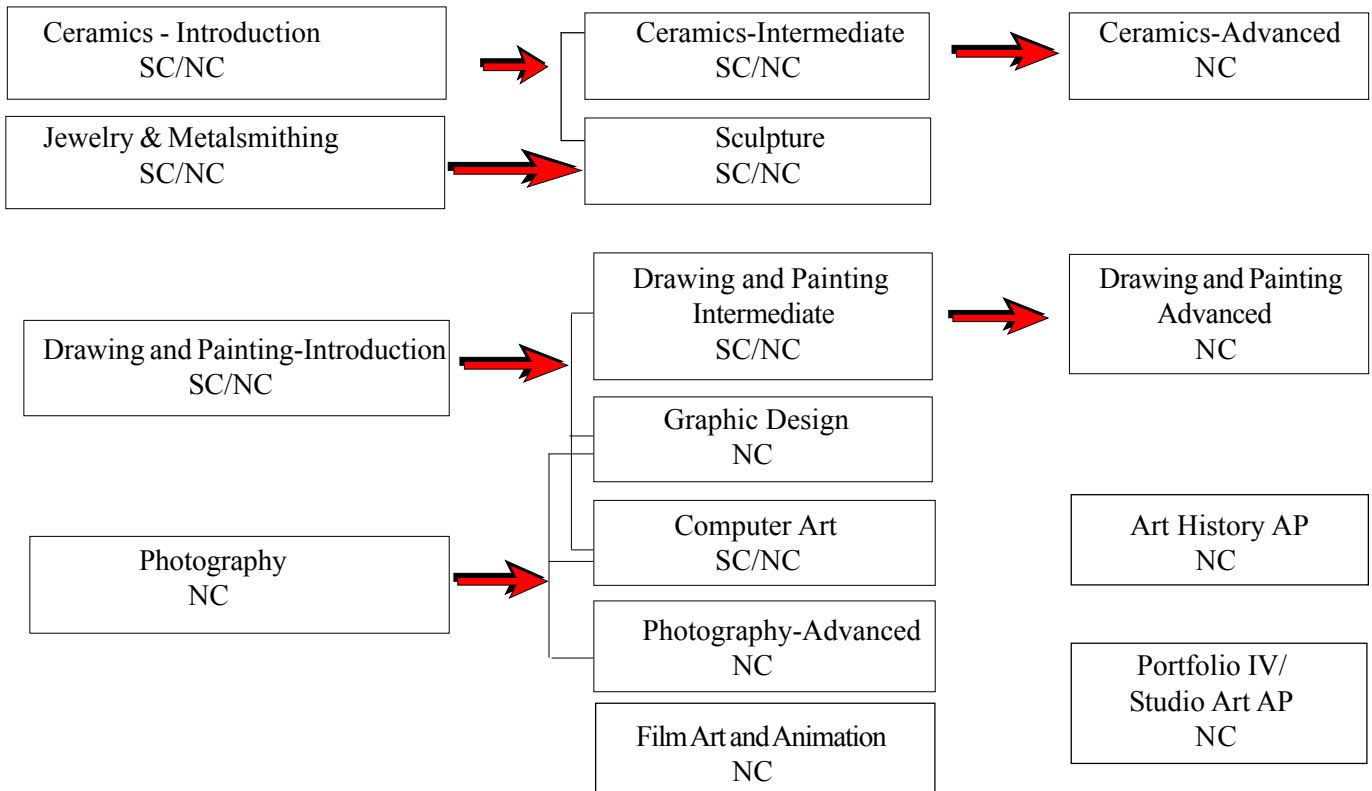

Between 2002 and 2012, the number or positions available for:

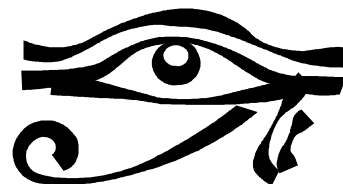
- Graphic Designers will increase by over 20%.

Those interested in art history, research, or business may be interested in museum work.

Art Administration Business and legal aspects of running a museum

Art Curator Conduct research, recommend works for acquisition, oversee physical condition of the collections, and assist in exhibition planning.

Conservator Restoration of art – requires knowledge of studio art as well as science.

Director of Education Arrange lectures, classes, workshops, outreach program in area schools

Registrar Keep track of the collection.
