

LTCAC Meeting on “Making LT Green”

December 12, 2007

A consensus was that the most effective action LT has taken to date was with energy efficient lighting. Other comments included the usage of environmentally safe cleaning products, the formation of a Recycling Club, the installation of fans, new windows and chiller replacement.

The area of continuing concern for the future was a better recycling plan with decreased paper usage as its goal along with better recycling education for students and staff.

A consensus viewed paper recycling as a key area for improvement. Suggestions were made to better educate students and staff about paper recycling, provide more bins, institute a tracking system on how much paper is recycled and to communicate same to students and staff, and to begin using recycled paper products. While this area was viewed as the most pressing, other suggestions made were a school assembly about recycling and a mention on the web site about LT’s “green” efforts.
