Community Advisory Council
Consensus of Table Discussions to Board Questions
April 21, 2010**

The Lyons Township Community Advisory Council has discussed the following questions and respectfully recommends that the Board of Education consider the following comments:

1. What other unique learning experience would you like to see LT consider?

From a consensus standpoint, the most often listed item asked for more opportunity for social action and service projects sponsored by LTHS as well as more practical arts and day-to-day hands-on experience of the “real world” such as medical field trips, and shadowing local business. Specifically, requests were made for a 21st century technology design development course and a clothing design course at South Campus. Mention was made of yearlong exchange programs and the addition of more countries to participate in an exchange program.

2. Inasmuch as LT is a conduit for these unique learning opportunities, should students receive more financial assistance? If so, what are possible funding sources?

Overall, the response pointed toward student fund-raising for individual trips as well as establishment of an LTHS Foundation, a more general fund-raising account and seeking out community funding and local business scholarships.

3. Of the four presentations made this evening, which one was your favorite and why?

All but one of the 7 tables found each presentation interesting and information. One singled out the aviation presentation. In general, the group indicated they learned aspects of programs they weren't aware of and feel this information should be put out to the general public. It really shows the opportunities offered for LT students.
