SECRETARY REPORT-Lynn Dunn presented the May 6, 2009 minutes. Nancy O'Brien motioned to approve. Karen King second. Minutes approved.

CORRESPONDING SECRETARY- Lisa Straface reported. No report.

TREASURER REPORT-Nancy O'Brien reported. Current balance Sept. 6, 2009 is \$4,457.67. This includes everything except Post Prom. The Steppers did spend their grant request money. We gave out 2 scholarships of \$500 each. The reception for Dr. Kelly was given \$500. Next month we will approve the budget, please have all budget amounts for your committee to Nancy within 2 weeks for her to prepare the budget. The check we received from registration for calendars and directories was \$59,390.00, this is more money than in past years due to the increase in fees and we believe more people purchased them. Prom start up amount of \$1000 is included in the student funding and is not the post prom line item. Motioned to approve. Second. Report approved.

PRESIDENTS REPORT-Ann Porter reported. Ann reported that registration went well we had enough volunteers except for the senior days. The poster used at registration promoting PTC will be used at the open houses at SC and NC, and then be used at Future Freshman night.

The bookstore reported that they had about $\frac{1}{2}$ dozen complaints regarding the increase in PTC fees. There are 2914 memberships in PTC up 221 from last year. The volunteer forms took longer to get scanned, they were reformatted last year and a new template had to be made this year to read it. The directories are at the printer and we are working on the envelopes and mailing process we will use to get them sent home. Dr. Kilrea will speak at the October meeting, we are sending around a paper to list questions for him. Our speaker for January will be Lianne Musser.

OPEN HOUSE-SOUTH CAMPUS-Maria Pekar reported SC open house is tomorrow she has not received the spreadsheet of volunteers, so is having to use the filled out scantron sheets. The NHS will be there to help. We will get some nametags for the volunteers that will be working at open house.

OPEN HOUSE-NORTH CAMPUS-Jennifer Hayes reported NC open house is next week. We will not sell directories and calendars but let people know if extras are needed they can be purchased at the school bookstore.

POST PROM-Barbara Wood and Ed Suarez reported. They presented the year ending balance sheets. Everything went great, no issues. They used 21 buses to transport the students. There were 695 students on the boat including chaperones. They are still looking for a major sponsor.
