

LTHS Homecoming Parade Information Saturday, October 14

If your club, team, student organization or group wishes to participate in the Homecoming Parade on Saturday, October 14, 2023, please read the following instructions and complete the form online at www.lths.net/Homecoming. This will assure you a spot in this year's parade. There are a few rules that must be followed to ensure everyone's safety, but the most important requirement is to *have fun!*

- 1. The parade route will begin at North Campus and will wind its way through the neighborhoods and Garden Market, ending up at South Campus. The parade will kick-off promptly at 10:00 a.m. In order to ensure that we start on time, we ask that all floats, vehicles, and participants be at the North Campus Parking lot by 8:30 a.m. Refreshments will be available in the morning. Judging will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. As a courtesy to our North Campus neighbors, we ask all groups to refrain from playing music (live or recorded) until after 9:45 a.m.
- 3. Once finished with the parade, the floats and vehicles will be allowed to remain in the South Campus Circle Drive so the public can view them. A lot of work goes into making those floats, and you deserve to show them off!
- 4. Be creative! This year's judges will evaluate each float and will award prizes accordingly. During the parade, magnetic banners will identify the winners to the community. Each winning club or group will be awarded \$100.00. The categories for judging are:
 - Most School Spirit
 - Best Theme Adaptation
 - Most Original
 - Most Colorful
 - Best Overall
