

COMMUTING STUDENT INFORMATION

LTHS offers courses 1st and 8th periods at the other campus to help our students fulfill their graduation requirements and personal interests. As a commuter, there are certain practices you need to be made aware of. Please read the following items carefully.

How do we get to the other campus?

- For 1st hour commuters, your morning bus route will take you directly to the campus of your 1st hour class. The commuter bus will bring you back to your home campus.
- For 8th hour commuters, the commuter bus will bring you to the other campus for class. You will take your assigned bus route home from there; you do not return to your home campus.
- You may only use the school provided transportation; students are not allowed drive between campuses.

Where are the commuter busses located?

- **SOUTH CAMPUS:** Drop-off and pick-up is in front of Times Square or the main entrance to the campus on Circle Drive.
- **NORTH CAMPUS:** Drop-off and pick-up is on Park Avenue, by exit #7.

When do busses depart to the other campus?

- Busses leave at the end of 1st hour and 7th hour bells.
- Students are to leave at the end of 1st hour and 7th hour classes **three minutes before the end of the period** to catch the bus. If your class is particularly far from the bus exit, please make arrangements with your teacher to leave five minutes early.

What do we do if we bus is late?

- If the bus is late getting to the other campus go to the AP Office to get a pass to class. This sometimes happens with inclement weather.
- If you are late and miss the commuter bus, go to the AP Office immediately.

What do we do on days with special schedules?

- On **late arrival days**, students **will commute** to the other campus.
- On **early dismissal days**, students **will not** commute. They are to report to and sign-in at the library of their home campus. (10/3/18, 12/5/18, 2/6/19 and 4/9/19)
- On **most assembly days**, students **will still commute**. However, there are some assembly and/or special schedules that do not allow enough time for commuting. **Students will not commute on the days of the All-School Assembly (2/8/19), SAT/PSAT testing (4/9/19), and the days of the Sophomore (5/16/19) and Senior (5/24/19) Honors Assemblies.** Listen to announcements for reminders. If you have a question, ask your classroom teacher or the Assistant Principals' Office.

Who do we go to for questions about commuting?

- Any of the staff in the Assistant Principals' Office can help you. Any Student Assistant can help as well.
